After this news story was conducted, we ran a survey to the Citizens in Peoria County to rate the safety of their neighborhood and local officials, including the City Council, yourself as the Mayor and the Police Departments (City and County).


My agency has also taken some time to place some FOIA requests with the City of Peoria and has taken that documentation received under review and some of which is concerning.

In our talks with community members, we've heard several people say they are afraid to leave their homes at night while some say that "the violence will never change".
